# The Bambino Room (Birth to Two Years)

Our Bambino Room is a dedicated baby environment designed to nurture, stimulate and support children from birth to two years. Rooted in warmth, responsive care and purposeful exploration, it provides the perfect space for our youngest children to thrive.

## A Base for Exploration

The Bambino Room acts as a secure base for babies to explore the wider nursery. With their key educators supporting them, Bambinos enjoy daily adventures into other classrooms, helping them build confidence, independence and a developing sense of belonging. These gentle transitions allow babies to explore varied environments while still feeling grounded by familiar adults.

## Our Curriculum: In-the-Moment Teaching and Seasonal Sequencing

In the Bambino Room, we blend in-the-moment responsive teaching with a gentle seasonal curriculum. Educators respond instantly to babies' cues, interests and emerging fascinations, nurturing communication, confidence and connection. Alongside this spontaneous learning, our sequenced seasonal curriculum introduces babies to natural changes, sensory experiences and meaningful celebrations. This supports progression in vocabulary, early physical development, curiosity and early thinking in a warm, developmentally appropriate way.

## Daily Trips and Community Adventures

Every day, our babies have opportunities to explore the outdoors and local community. Whether it's a walk to feed the ducks, visiting the local library, or exploring natural spaces, these experiences develop early curiosity, communication and an understanding of the world.

## Learning Through Play

We offer a rich variety of stimulating activities, including:

- **Messy play:** gloop, paint, water and sensory trays that support early cognitive and physical development.
- **Roleplay:** simple pretend-play experiences that encourage early communication and social awareness.
- **Singing and music time:** daily sessions that support bonding, rhythm and early language.
- **Outdoor exploration:** regular time outdoors to build physical development and confidence.



## Our Preschool Classrooms (Ages 2–4)

Our classrooms for children aged two to four are vibrant, dynamic and filled with opportunities for exploration, independence and purposeful learning. Children are encouraged to follow their interests, make choices and take ownership of their learning, supported closely by skilled early years educators who extend thinking and scaffold development.

### Free-Flow Learning

Our free-flow approach allows children to move confidently between learning spaces throughout the day. This empowers them to:

- Make independent decisions about their play
- Build confidence through autonomy
- Develop self-regulation and problem-solving skills
- Engage with a range of environments that inspire curiosity

Children learn to trust their instincts, follow their interests and manage their own routines with increasing independence.

### A Rich Range of Opportunities

Across our classrooms, children can engage in a wide variety of stimulating experiences, including:

- **Imaginative roleplay:** home corners, small-world play and themed setups that spark creativity and language development.
- **Creative and messy play:** painting, playdough, water, clay and sensory exploration that build fine motor skills and imagination.
- **Expressive arts:** music, dance, movement and mark-making that help children express ideas and emotions.
- **Outdoor learning:** continued access to our all-weather garden, promoting physical development and adventurous play.





## **Focused Literacy and Mathematics**

While play is at the heart of our offer, we also provide developmentally appropriate, focused learning opportunities to prepare children for school.

These include:

- Early phonics games and stories
- Mark-making and beginning writing experiences
- Counting, sorting, problem-solving and number exploration
- Opportunities to develop early comprehension, communication and vocabulary

These sessions are playful, hands-on and child-centred — designed to ignite a love of learning while building foundations for future success.

## **Our Curriculum: In-the-Moment Teaching and Seasonal Sequencing**

In our preschool classrooms, educators expertly weave together in-the-moment responsive teaching with a sequenced seasonal curriculum. While practitioners extend learning through spontaneous teachable moments, the seasonal sequence ensures children build knowledge progressively — from understanding nature and celebrations to developing early literacy, mathematics, communication and expressive arts skills. Together, these approaches strengthen confidence, communication and readiness for school.

Our preschool classrooms provide the perfect balance of structure and freedom, empowering children aged 2–4 to explore, experiment and grow into confident, capable learners.



# *The Outdoor Play Area*

## **Outdoor Learning and Our Fantastic Facilities**

At Nippers Nursery, outdoor learning is at the heart of our curriculum. We believe that the outdoors offers children unparalleled opportunities for exploration, independence, imagination and physical development.

### **Purpose-Built, All-Weather Garden**

Our large, purpose-built outdoor garden is designed to be used in all seasons and all weathers. With open-ended resources, natural materials and a layout that invites curiosity, children are encouraged to:

- Build, climb and balance
- Engage in imaginative play
- Explore nature and wildlife
- Develop physical strength and coordination

Rain or shine, children have the freedom to move, discover and test their abilities.

### **Exploring the Local Community**

Outdoor learning extends beyond our gates. We take regular excursions into the local community, giving children real-world learning opportunities. These include visits to:

- Local parks and green spaces
- The river and surrounding nature trails
- Local shops, cafés and community spots
- The library and local events

These experiences help children develop a sense of place, learn about the world around them and build confidence in new environments.

### **Learning Through Adventure**

Our outdoor practice emphasises exploration, risk-taking in a safe environment and hands-on, sensory-rich experiences. Whether children are digging in mud, collecting natural treasures, or working together to build structures, they are developing resilience, teamwork, problem-solving skills and a deep connection with nature.

### **Our Curriculum: In-the-Moment Teaching and Seasonal Sequencing**

Outdoors, our curriculum blends spontaneous, child-led exploration with a sequenced, seasonally driven approach. Practitioners notice and build on children's immediate interests — whether insects, weather, movement or imaginative play — while the seasonal structure deepens understanding of nature, weather patterns, wildlife and environmental concepts. This combined approach ensures children develop curiosity, vocabulary and problem-solving skills rooted in real, meaningful experiences. This sequenced approach ensures children develop deep knowledge, vocabulary and respect for the natural world while gaining essential physical and problem-solving skills.



## ***The Kitchen and Dining Room***

On arrival children help themselves to breakfast and then during the morning a snack tray is delivered to each room. The children sit together chatting and munching on fresh fruit, organic milk or water and a light snack.

There is always a cafe table in the kitchen that the children can access at any time, and every room has a supply of drinking water.

A two-course lunch is served at 12 noon which is then followed by an afternoon café and a two- course tea is served from 4pm.



All snacks, lunches and tea are cooked on the premises. Locally sourced ingredients are used to create a varied and delicious menu which the children are heavily involved in preparing.

Weekly menus are displayed in the hallway, on our Family App and emailed via Mailchimp.

Special diets are catered for as best we can Everything is made freshly from scratch in the 5\* rated kitchen each morning.



## Opening Times + Fees

The nursery is open Monday to Friday 7.30am – 6.00pm, 52 ish weeks a year as we are closed for staff training and a few extra days over the Christmas and New Year period.

A £200 Non-Refundable deposit will be requested to secure your child's place. The deposit will be deducted from your first invoice.

Fees are payable monthly in advance and are non-returnable if your child is ill or on holiday.

A funded full day is 8am – 6pm 10 hrs  
A morning Session 8.30am – 1.30pm 5 hrs  
An afternoon session 1pm – 6pm 5 hrs

The funding does not cover the cost of meals, consumables and additional services, so we ask for a voluntary contribution towards these costs on funded days/sessions

For ease most parents choose to pay for meals, daily charges and enjoy the additional services but if you would like to opt out, we can discuss your requirements and provide a list of all the items you would need to provide

Here is an example of what you're entitled to & how it is calculated based on a child who attends a pattern of 3 full days per week and is entitled to 30 hrs of funding from April 26 to March 27

How the funding is applied to my invoice:

The funded hours are allocated to attending 3 days termtime only, additional days that your child attends are charged separately

Our standard daily charge is: £84 Childcare £13 Meals £3 Consumables + Additional Services

10 hrs per day 8am – 6 pm are FREE during Term time

Early Bird Drop Off before 8am £4 per funded day

Additional charges for meals, consumables and additional services are applied to the funded term time days £13 Meals + £3 Consumables + Additional Services

We'll miss the warmth and happiness that fills Nippers, but we'll carry the memories with us always!

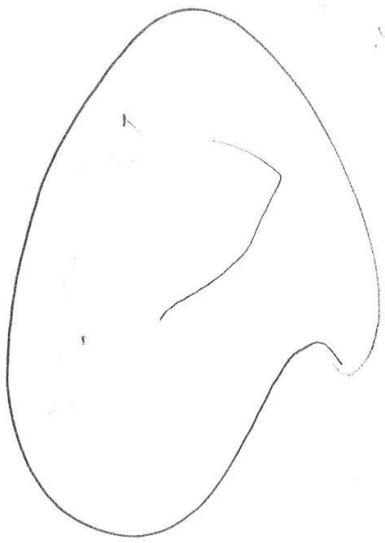

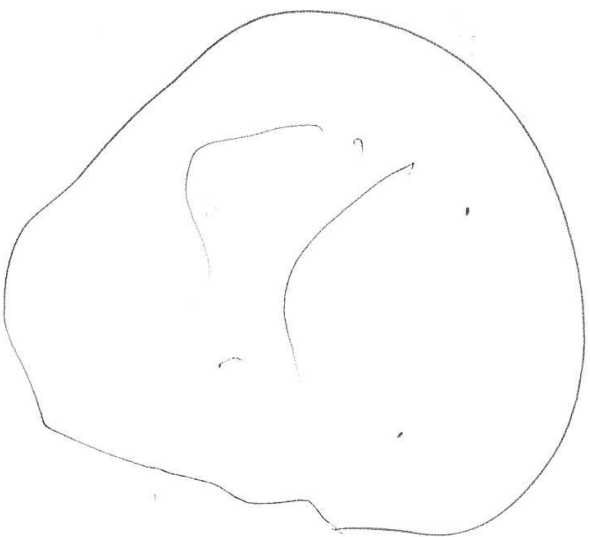
